## Factors causing physiological disorders in cabbage

Suggested sowing time: Sowing time applies to the area of seedling nursery and farm location

- Wrong sowing time
- Cold temperatures, especially below $7^{\circ} \mathrm{C}$
- Excessive fertilisation of seedlings
- Cold grown seedlings
- Oversized seedlings at transplant
- Difference in temperatures between seedling nursery and farm
- Growth checks caused by heat, drought, water logging and disease
- Diurnal temperature swings
